

## Video tutorial

### 1. Install the iSKI Tracker app.

2. Open the iSKI Tracker app.

3. Click on >>LOG IN<<.

4. Click on >>Already registered?<<.

5. Login:

a) If you have not yet created an account:

→ Click on >>Create an account<<.

b) If you have already registered:

→ Fill in the top two fields with:

    → Your email address

    → Your password

→ Click on >>Login<< to confirm

### 6. Registration (if you do not yet have an account!!)

Enter the following:

→ Your email address

→ A password

→ You must re-enter your password for verification purposes!

Confirm that you agree to the terms of use by clicking the **button (slider)**

→ To proceed to the next step, click >>Register<<

→ You can now personalize your profile (name, date of birth, etc.)

→ Click >>Register<<

### 7. Email confirmation

Check your email inbox; you should receive an email within a few minutes.

→ Confirm your registration by clicking on the “Activation button” in the email.

→ Reopen the iSKI Tracker app and go through section Login: 5b.) to log in.

### Link your ski pass

→ Click on >>ME<< in the navigation bar at the bottom right of the screen.

→ Scroll/navigate down a little and click on >>Check ski pass - iSKI Analytics<<.

→ Select **the ski resort** where you want to use this ski pass

→ Click on >>Keycards<< in the top bar

→ Now press >>Accept<< for the terms of use

**You will now see an overview of your saved keycards**

→ Click on >>Add new ski pass<<

→ Select the card type:

In Hinterstoder, the default selection is >>4-part (front)<<

→ Enter your ski pass number

→ Give your keycard a name (for your own recognition)

\*Example: Hinterstoder 2026 season pass

\*Example: Day pass 15.01.2026

→ Click on >>Save keycard<< if you want to save your entry

### Track your day of skiing

→ Click on the tracking button in the navigation bar at the bottom center of the screen

→ Click on >>Start Tracking > <<

→ When you finish your day of skiing, click on >>Stop Tracking<<
